



Editorial Submission Information

RF Globalnet (www.rfglobalnet.com) accepts editorial submissions for possible inclusion on its Web site and in the RF Globalnet e-mail newsletter, which is sent twice a week to over 34,000 subscribers. Acceptable submissions should be on topics relevant to an RF/microwave engineering audience and may include (but are not limited to):

- News releases
- Technical articles
- Application notes
- White papers
- Guest columns
- Tutorials
- Market overviews
- Case studies
- Product features

News Release Submission Guidelines

- News releases must be both recent (within two weeks of release) and relevant (on topics important to RF/microwave engineers).
- Acceptable subjects include (but are not limited to): new product announcements, research news, mergers and acquisitions, market updates, regulatory/standards announcements, industry alliance/consortia news, contract awards, trade show news, facility moves/updates, personnel changes, new literature/Web sites, etc.
- In general, press releases should be between 200 and 800 words in length and may include images (number included is at editor's discretion).
- Submissions should be in Word or PDF format (or embedded in an e-mail), with graphics in JPEG or GIF format, to the RF Globalnet editorial staff at rfgeditor@vertmarkets.com.
- News releases are posted to the Current Headlines, Firms and Faces, Event News, or Literature and Web Site News sections of RF Globalnet, as appropriate.
- RF Globalnet reserves the right to deem any submission as unacceptable.



Article Submission Guidelines

- Articles should be previously unpublished (either in print or Web venues) and should be of interest to an RF/microwave engineering audience.
- Acceptable formats include (but are not limited to): technical articles, application notes, white papers, guest columns, tutorials, market overviews, etc.
- A brief abstract should be sent to the RF Globalnet editorial staff (rfgeditor@vertmarkets.com) for review at least six weeks prior to the publication date.
- If the abstract is accepted, you will be asked to submit a final manuscript in Word or PDF format with images included (as separate attachments, with placeholders/captions included in the manuscript) for review at least one month prior to the publication date.
- As a Web site, RF Globalnet does not have specific word-count or size limits, but in general, we are looking for articles that are 1,500 to 3,000 words in length with at least 5 to 10 images.
- A brief author bio and headshot (in GIF or JPEG format) may be included.
- The final article will be posted to the RF Globalnet [Download Library](#) in PDF format; a short excerpt will also be posted to the [Featured Articles](#) section of the site, with a link to the complete article in the Download Library.
- RF Globalnet reserves the right to deem any submission as unacceptable.

Download Library Submission Guidelines

- Downloads should be of interest to an RF/microwave engineering audience. Previously unpublished submissions are preferred, though published pieces may be considered (with necessary reprint permission obtained by the author).
- Acceptable formats include (but are not limited to): product features, case studies, application notes, etc.
- A brief abstract should be sent to the RF Globalnet editorial staff (rfgeditor@vertmarkets.com) for review at least six weeks prior to the publication date.
- If the abstract is accepted, you will be asked to submit a final manuscript in Word or PDF format, with images included (embedded in text), for review at least one month prior to the publication date.
- As a Web site, RF Globalnet does not have specific word-count or size limits, but in general, we are looking for downloads that are no fewer than 800 words in length with at least three to five images.
- The final article will be posted to the RF Globalnet [Download Library](#) in PDF format with a brief abstract.
